WIC Appointment Policy

We are glad you're part of our WIC Program. In order to serve you promptly in our clinic, we have established some helpful tips and reminders to keep your visit moving quickly.

Please bring the following to your Certification/Recertification appointment:

- Child or infant who the appointment is for.
- Proof of identification for yourself and all children scheduled. Examples include: driver's license or photo I.D., immunization record, birth certificate, crib card, social security card.
- Medicaid cards for everyone who is scheduled.
- Proof of income: 3 current pay stubs of employment from each employed person in the home. Child support, unemployment benefits, social security benefits, or any other source of income.
- Proof of residency: Any document that states current name and address.
- Proof of pregnancy (if applicable): Statement from your Doctor or an ultrasound picture we can photocopy that has your name and current date on it.

HELPFUL HINTS for making your WIC appointment a pleasurable experience:

- ✓ Please call us before your appointment with any questions that you may have, at 419-334-6363.
- ✓ All participants are weighed and measured, and most will have their iron checked. You may find it helpful to bring someone with you to help with your children during the visit.
- ☆ Every effort is made to see you promptly at the time of your appointment. Being prepared before you arrive, helps us see you at your scheduled time. Thank you for participating in the WIC Program, we look forward to serving you!
