IT IS THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN!

At the start of the school year, Sandusky
County Public Health's Environmental Health
Specialists inspect the school kitchens,
buildings, and classrooms. These inspections
are essential to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all students and faculty. It's vital to
this department to maintain the highest
environmental health standards. Rest
assured, the inspectors are working hard to
meet this goal. So when you see them at your
child's school, please know that they are
inspecting to ensure everyone stays safe and
healthy.



COMMON VIOLATIONS:

One of the most frequently observed violations by our inspectors pertains to improper cooling parameters. According to the Ohio Food Safety Codes, the cooling of cooked food must adhere to strict guidelines. Specifically, cooked food should be cooled from 135 degrees F to 70 degrees F within two hours. Following this, it must be cooled from 70 degrees F to 41 degrees F or below within four hours. Failure to comply with these regulations can lead to potential health hazards.

Several methods can be used to achieve safe food storage parameters. These include dividing large quantities of food into smaller, shallow pans, placing foods into an ice bath or using an ice wand, placing foods directly into a refrigerator that is 41 degrees F or colder, and leaving containers open and covering them once they have cooled to the proper temperatures. This helps prevent bacteria from developing and condensation from accumulating.
