Case counts include the number of disease reports received throughout the month of August 2026. Disease and Case Inclusion Criteria: Suspect, Probable, and Confirmed.

Key Finding Comparisons/Special Notes

- The Salmonellosis cases were confirmed as *Salmonella* infection, with laboratory testing identifying serotypes *Salmonella* Montevideo, Newport, and Enteritidis (2).
- An increase in the detection of other enteric pathogens has also been observed during the Cyclospora investigation. This may be attributable, in part, to increased gastrointestinal testing and use of multiplex PCR panels, which can simultaneously detect multiple enteric pathogens. Increased testing may result in identification of infections that may have otherwise gone undiagnosed.
- Influenza reporting links will be emailed and faxed to providers, LTCF's and school districts for the 2026-27 season. The start of influenza season begins September 28, 2026 (Week 40).

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
