What is TIES?

The Teen Immunization Education Sessions (TIES) Program is a free statewide provider immunization education and training program developed for health-care providers. This continuing education program, which trains practices in techniques to improve adolescent immunization rates in their practice, is offered through the Ohio Chapter, American Academy of Pediatrics (Ohio AAP), and funded by the Ohio Department of Health with technical assistance from the National Immunization Program, Centers for Disease Control & Prevention.

TIES Attendees also receive the latest information available on:

- Immunization recommendations
- New vaccines
- Missed opportunities
- Common misconceptions
- Practice-based consultation
- Immunization strategies for optimal practice

TIES is a one-hour in-office continuing education program provided by trained vaccine experts. Target offices include pediatric and family medicine practices throughout Ohio. TIES aims to raise immunization rates among Ohio's children by teaching physicians and their entire staff evidence-based strategies to overcome barriers to immunization.
